# INTRODUCTION

"Guiding tools for Professionals Skills Development in VET" (VET\_GPS) is an Erasmus+ project, involving 8 partners from 5 countries (Portugal, Spain, Italy, Austria and Belgium)

VET\_GPS focuses on the acquisition, development and assessment of SOFT-SKILLS of trainees attending VET Training, essential for their personal development, social participation and workplace success.

SOFT-SKILLS, often referred to as transversal skills or competences, key skills, core skills or life skills, are recognised to be a successful factor enabling individuals' well-being, self-confidence, autonomy and responsibility, fulfilment of education/social and professional lives, career development and higher income.
